In July of this year, I had the honour of being elected as ABHI Chair, leading our Board during a pivotal time for our industry. As a collective, we are committed to providing leadership that both supports and challenges, ensuring the best outcomes for our members and the wider HealthTech community.

This is a crucial period for ABHI, particularly as we advocate to keep the UK a competitive market for HealthTech, ensuring safe and timely patient access to innovative technologies. At our recent UK HealthTech Conference, ABHI colleagues underscored that regulatory uncertainty and cost continues to pose a major barrier, significantly affecting investment decisions and the flow of innovation into the UK. Additional concerns around the NHS Net Zero Roadmap and procurement challenges further complicate the landscape, requiring urgent solutions.

As we enter a busy autumn period, I believe ABHI's role in holding policymakers to account, in order to find appropriate and swift solutions, has never been more important.

At our recent quarterly Board meeting, we addressed these pressing matters and reviewed the Association's strategy for the coming months. One key focus for the Board is to elevate the role of the Member Groups, ensuring stronger connectivity between the work you do and the Board's oversight. I would welcome any feedback on this approach, so please do write to me if there are issues you would like raised. Your insights are invaluable as we continue shaping the future of our industry together.





Welcoming leads from across the NHS, surgeons in the field, ABHI members and our colleagues in Europe, we held our annual **Sustainability Conference** this September.



With an objective of further developing one of the UK's most cohesive healthcare ecosystems, we signed a refreshed **Memorandum of Understanding** with the West Yorkshire HealthTech Cluster in July.



Covering all matters regulation and market access across two days, we welcomed 400 attendees to the annual **ABHI UK HealthTech Conference**.



The Procurement Act 2023, which received Royal Assent last year, is designed to update the way in which the public sector buys goods and services. To detail what this will mean for ABHI members, we were pleased to host a webinar with colleagues from Burges Salmon this September.

Members of the ABHI leadership team supported an expert briefing session with **Health Innovation Yorkshire & Humber** in July. Aimed at SMEs, the session focussed on the requirements for HealthTech adoption, with Phil Brown and Luella Trickett detailing to attendees key policies relating to regulation, procurement and sustainability.
